The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cumberland County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated January 23, 2015. The subject request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes for the revision to accept asphalt material with the existing concrete, brick, and block, not to exceed 350 tons per day, at C&H Enterprises, LLC (Thompson's Recycling Center). The facility is located at Block 24, Lot 26, in Fairfield Township, Cumberland County.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b) 6, the revised County Plan to accept asphalt material constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f). This administrative action approval should not be construed as an expression to issue a permit modification.
