The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cumberland County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 6, 2016. The request proposes County Plan inclusion to remove Cumberland Recycling Corp. as a Class A recycling facility and re- classify it as a scrap processing facility located at 2159 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Millville, NJ 08332.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility with on-site operational changes can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County plan inclusion to remove Cumberland Recycling Corp. as a Class A recycling facility and re-classify it as a scrap processing facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
