The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cumberland County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 9, 2014. The April 9, 2014 requests that the NJDEP approve the amendment of the County Plan to modify the existing Cumberland County Recycling Program. Specifically, the Cumberland County Improvement Authority (CCIA) would like to move from "Dual Stream" recycling to "Single Stream" recycling. The CCIA believes that this modification will better enable the County to achieve the 50% municipal solid and 60% total solid waste recycling mandate.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 6, the modifications of a recycling program constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
