Dear Mr. Rocco:

On May 23, 2011, the Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program received an administrative action from the Cumberland County Improvement Authority concerning the Kennedy Concrete, Inc. Class B Recycling Facility located at Block 968, Lot 1 in the City of Vineland. This administrative action proposes to increase Kennedy Concrete Inc. Class B recycling facility's daily limit from 186 tons per day to 300 tons per day (tpd) of Class B material.

On May 11, 2000, the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted an amendment into their County Plan to include the Kennedy Concrete Inc. facility located on Block 968, Lot 1, in the City of Vineland, as a recycling center for Class B material, specifically concrete. This amendment was certified as approved by the Department on October 9, 2000.

On October 4, 2000, the Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste received an application for a general approval from Kennedy Concrete, Inc. Class B Recycling Facility to accept 186 tpd of Class B material, specifically concrete. The general approval was issued by the Department on June 7, 2001.

On February 7, 2011, the Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program approved an administrative action to include the acceptance of asphalt, brick/block, concrete material, and utilize the capacity of unprocessed material stockpile space for processed/unprocessed material as long as the total volume does not exceed 12,115 cubic yards.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5., the modification of an existing facility including the increase of daily tonnage constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request to increase the Kennedy Concrete Inc. Class B Recycling Facility's daily acceptance limit to 300 tpd is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a general approval to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
