The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Cumberland County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 7, 2018. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion to remove "Food Waste" from (Table F-1) as a mandatory Designated Recyclable Material for the "Commercial and Institutional" sector of the County Plan.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b)6, the modification of a recycling program to remove a Designated Recyclable Material from the County Plan can be accomplished via an administrative action.
