The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Cumberland County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan) dated August 19, 2024. This amendment to the Cumberland County Plan proposes plan inclusion of updated facility hours of operation and Block and Lot numbers for South State Inc. into the County Plan. The facility is located on Block 1, Lots 18, 20, 21.03, 28, and 30, 202 Reeves Road in the Township of Fairfield. The operating hours for receiving, storing, and transferring materials are 7:00 AM -7:00 PM, Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM-12:00 PM on Saturday. Hours of operation for processing materials are 24 hours per day, Monday through Saturday. In addition, the amendment proposes the removal of the previously approved accepted materials petroleum contaminated soil and materials for wood recycling (trees, tree parts, branches, clean non-painted and non-treated wood). The approved tonnage accepted per day will remain the same at 3750 tons for the accepted materials of concrete, asphalt, brick, and block.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of updated operating hours and Black and Lot details as well as the removal of previously accepted materials in the Cumberland County Solid Waste Management Plan can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan amendments are hereby approved as an Administrative Action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6:11.
