Dear Mr. Herrmann,

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Essex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 27, 2016. The request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Advanced Enterprises Recycling, LLC Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located on Block 5070, Lots 25, 41 and 43 at 540 Doremus Avenue in the City of Newark. Traffic routes for solid waste vehicles departing each municipality in the County, with the exception of the City of Newark which hosts the facility, are specified in the April 27, 2016 request for administrative action to the County Plan.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)2, the inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing a solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing Advanced Enterprises Recycling, LLC TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
