The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Essex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 22, 2015. This request for administrative action to the County Plan, proposes County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles to and from two Lemcor, Inc. TS/MRF. The Foundry Street facility is located on properties designated as 221 Foundry Street, Newark, New Jersey, Block 5005, Lots 1 and 15. The Frelinghuysen Avenue facility is located on properties designated as 170 Frelinghuysen Avenue, Newark, New Jersey, Block 2755, Lots 46 and 1; Block 2780, Lots 28 and 32. This request for administrative action to the County Plan also notes that all routes to be employed within a respective municipality are governed by any and all applicable municipal ordinances.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 2, the inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles to and from certain solid waste facilities can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of designated solid waste vehicle routes to and from the Lemcor, Inc. Frelinghuysen Avenue and Foundry Street facilities are hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
