
The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Essex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 22, 2016. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Evergreen Recycling Solutions, LLC Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located on Block 3779, Lots 20, 28 & 92 at 110 Evergreen Avenue in the City of Newark. Traffic routes for solid waste vehicles departing each municipality in the County, with the exception of the City of Newark which hosts the facility, are specified in the June 22, 2016 request for administrative action to the County Plan.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)2, the inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing a solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing Evergreen Recycling Solutions, LLC TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

The June 22, 2016 submittal also requested a name change of the entity to Evergreen Recycling Solutions, LLC. This was previously approved by the Department in an administrative action dated July 30, 2012.
