The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Essex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated September 25, 2019. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan deletion of Lemcor, Inc. Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility located at 221 Foundry Street (Block 5005, Lots 1.02, 3, 7 & 15) in the City of Newark.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)7, the deletion of any facility which is included in the County Plan for more than two years, but has not operated for more than two years can be accomplished via an administrative action.
