The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste (Department) is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Essex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated November 18, 2015. This request proposes County Plan inclusion to accept waste type ID 23 (vegetative) as an additional waste at Lemcor, Inc. located at 170 Frelinghuysen Avenue, Newark (Essex County). This additional waste type would not include any change in the total tonnage the facility is currently permitted to accept and further would not result in any changes to the facility's operations or hours of operation.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5, the inclusion of an existing facility to accept waste type ID 23 as an additional waste, can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, this administrative action is hereby approved pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
