The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Gloucester County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan), dated July 18, 2016. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion to modify the change in operating hours at the Gloucester County Solid Waste Complex (GCSWC) located at 493 Monroeville Road, in Swedesboro. The hours of operation will change from the current Monday-Friday 7:30 am- 3:30 pm to Monday-Friday 7:00 am-4:00 pm and the current hours for Saturday will change from 8:00 am-2:00 pm to 8:00 am- 4:00 pm. GCSWC is currently open the first Saturday of each month (pending legal Holidays, then it is the second Saturday), which would remain the same.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, a change in operating hours of an existing facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion for the change in operating hours for the GCSWC is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
