Dear Ms. Gilpin:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Hudson County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated February 14, 2017. This request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of:

- Revised block and lot designations, and;
- Designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Cardella Trucking Co., Inc. Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located at 2400 Tonnelle Avenue in the Township of North Bergen.

Specifically, the original County Plan inclusion documentation for the property listed Block 27, Lot 45 and Block 55, Lots A.1 and A.2. Due to the Township of North Bergen re-designating the parcels comprising the Facility on its Tax Map, the revised designation is Block 27.01, Lot 45 and Block 55, Lots 1 and 2. Additionally, traffic routes for solid waste vehicles traveling to and from the Facility via various roadways are specified in the February 14, 2017 request for administrative action to the County Plan.

The County Plan inclusion of the above noted changes in the block and lot designation and the designation of truck traffic routes of Cardella Trucking Co., Inc. TS/MRF will not result in any operational changes at the facility.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, a change in the block and lot designation of an existing solid waste facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)2, the inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing a solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of changes in the block and lot designation and the designation of traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Cardella Trucking Co., Inc. TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
