Dear Ms. Gilpin:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Hudson County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 16, 2017. This request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of an additional 2,500 tons per day of petroleum contaminated soils at the Durable Recycling, LLC Class B Recycling Center located at 85 East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (Block 359, Lots 4.05, 4.06 and 10) in the City of Bayonne. In summary, the total maximum capacity that the facility will accept daily will be 1,500 tons per day of asphalt, brick, cinder block, concrete, stone, rock, ceramic materials, and wood and 2,500 tons per day of petroleum contaminated soils for a total of 4,000 tons per day.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)4, the inclusion of an expansion of capacity of any size, other than that specified at N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.10(b) 8 and 10, for any regulated solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the inclusion of acceptance of additional waste types can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the increase in capacity and the acceptance of an additional waste type at the Durable Recycling, LLC Class B Recycling Center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
