The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Mercer County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 21, 2016. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion for the name change and transfer of ownership (TOO) of the Ewing Township Compost Facility to the new owner Ewing Realty Partners Compost Facility. The facility is located at Block 13, Lots 3, 17, and 37, in Ewing Township, Mercer County.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b) 14, the inclusion for a name change and TOO can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion for a name change and TOO from Ewing Township Compost Facility to Ewing Realty Partners Compost Facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f).
