The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Mercer County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 27, 2019. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion to increase the tonnage of accepted regulated medical waste (from various offices throughout Mercer County) from 150 pounds per day (ppd) to 300 ppd, at the Pond Run Associates/Hamilton Pet Meadow Regulated Medical Waste Collection Facility located at 1500 Klockner Road, Block 1804, Lot 95 in the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, inclusion to increase the tonnage at a regulated medical waste collection facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
