The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of the June 1, 2006 request for administrative action. This administrative action proposes to include in the Mercer County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) an increase of 99 tons per day in the permitted capacity of the Mercer County Improvement Authority solid waste transfer station located in Ewing Township. This administrative action will have the effect of increasing the daily permitted facility waste acceptance from 1,000 tons per day to 1,099 tons per day.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 4., the expansion of capacity of any size, other than that specified at N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.10(b)8 and (b)10, for any regulated solid waste facility constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
