The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 18, 2022. Administrative Action 003-22 to the County Plan proposes plan inclusion of the Central Jersey Waste & Recycling, Inc. d/b/a Solterra Recycling Solutions located at 986 Jersey Avenue (Block 598, Lot 6) in the City of New Brunswick for acceptance of up to 250 tons per day of Class A recyclable materials (glass, metal, paper, plastic, and cardboard). The facility will be located at an existing Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) – 986 Jersey Avenue, LLC. The 250 tons per day of Class A recyclable materials will be included in the overall TS/MRF capacity of 1,900 tons per day. The operating hours will be Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility including the acceptance of additional waste types can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of Class A recyclable materials is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f).
