The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 23, 2018. Administrative Action 002-18 to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the modification to the capacity of the Clean Earth of Carteret Class B recycling center located on Block 1, Lot 3.02 at 24 Middlesex Avenue in the Borough of Carteret. The facility is included to accept up to 4,000 tons per day (tpd) of asphalt, concrete, brick, block, stone, and non-hazardous petroleum contaminated soil with a weekly averaging tonnage for all materials of 28,000 tons with a maximum amount on any given day of 4,700 tons.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)3, the modification of a recycling facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the capacity modification at the Clean Earth of Carteret Class B recycling center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
