The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated August 3, 2016. Administrative Action 002-16 to the County Plan proposes plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Republic Services of New Jersey, LLC New Brunswick Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF), d/b/a Midco Waste Systems, located at 4 & 5 Industrial Drive (Block 597.02, Lot 4 and Block 597.01, Lot 9.04) in the City of New Brunswick. Administrative Action 002-16 to the County Plan includes specific routes to the subject facility from Interstate 287, US Route 1, NJ Route 18 and NJ Route 27. All solid waste vehicles will access the facility via Industrial Drive.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)2, the inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing a solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of designated traffic routes for solid waste vehicles accessing the Republic Services of New Jersey, LLC TS/MRF in the City of New Brunswick, is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
