Dear Mr. Newman:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Monmouth County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated January 4, 2021. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of Delisa Waste Services ("Delisa") located at 101 Commerce Drive, Block 144, Lot 5.03, in the Borough of Tinton Falls to accept up to 60 tons/week of "Class A" single stream material at its facility for sorting into some of its constituent materials and then transfer the separated materials to a Class A recycling facility.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the operational modification of an existing facility to accept Class A recyclable materials can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, County Plan inclusion of Class A material at Delisa is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
