Dear Mr. Newman:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Monmouth County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated January 20, 2015. The administrative action request proposes to amend the County Plan by including Mazza & Sons, Inc. located at Shafto Road on Lot No. 26.01, Block 145, in the Borough of Tinton Falls, Monmouth County to operate a Class A recycling facility. The facility may receive no more than ten (10) tons per day of Class A recyclable materials consisting of aluminum and tin cans, cardboard, glass and paper combined. The total amount of unprocessed Class A material consisting of aluminum and tin cans, cardboard, glass and paper stored on-site shall not exceed 120 cubic yards and shall be stored in four (4) thirty(30) cubic yard roll-off containers to be located at unspecified locations throughout the permitted site.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5., on-site operational changes at an existing facility may be considered for approval through the administrative action process. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
