Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Monmouth County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 26, 2021. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion to request a temporary emergency increase to the weekly capacity for the Mazza Recycling Services, LTD Class A Recycling Facility ("Mazza") located at 3230 Shafto Road, Block 145, Lot 26.01 in the Borough of Tinton Falls, from the current limit of 1800 tons per week to 3600 tons per week. Under the previously approved weekly averaging plan, the facility could process up to 600 tons per day, six days per week and that will remain the same. This temporary approval will automatically expire or be extended by the County by July 31, 2021.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility including on-site operational changes can be accomplished via an administration action. Therefore, a temporary emergency increase to the weekly capacity at Mazza is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
