The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Monmouth County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 17, 2019. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion to change the name of the ReCommunity Farmingdale, LLC Class A Recycling Facility located at 15 Railroad Avenue, Block 30, Lot 1, in the Borough of Farmingdale to Republic Services of Farmingdale. The above noted change in name will not result in any operational changes at the facility.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of a change in name of an existing recycling center can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of a change in name of the ReCommunity Farmingdale, LLC Class A Recycling Facility to Republic Services of Farmingdale is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
