Dear Mr. Zaayenga:

On December 15, 2010 the Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program received the December 13, 2010 request for an administrative action from Monmouth County concerning the Deponte Class B recycling facility located at Block 5, Lot 4 in Howell Township. On June 5, 1997 the Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program received the May 22, 1997 resolution adopted by the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders that included into the Monmouth County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan), via the County's blanket inclusion policy, Deponte Construction Company.

The December 13, 2010 administrative action proposes the following changes: the change of owner/operator of the facility to Resource Engineering, LLC.; and, the inclusion of 220 tons per day of trees, brush, stumps and other natural wood products.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5., the operational changes of an existing facility constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
