Dear Mr. Gindoff:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated September 21, 2017. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the revised daily capacity limits at the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority's (MCMUA) Class B/C Recycling Center located at 500 West Hanover Avenue (Block 7; Lot 2) in the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills. The proposed amendment requests the inclusion of the revised daily capacity of the Class B operation to 72 tons per day of brush with an annual capacity of no more than 3,500 cubic yards per year.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the revision of daily capacity limits of an existing recycling facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the revised daily capacity of brush accepted at the Class B operation of the MCMUA Class B/C Recycling Center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
