The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority (NJSEA) District Solid Waste Management Plan (District Plan) dated June 11, 2014. This amendment, adopted by the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority Board of Commissioners on May 14, 2015, supports an amendment to the NJSEA District Plan that proposes to include the modification/expansion of the existing NY/NJ Recycling, LLC Class A recycling facility, located at 800 Page Avenue, Block 235, Lot 23 in the Township of Lyndhurst, Bergen County from 100 to 200 tons per day (tpd) of Class A recyclable materials.

Although initiated as a plan amendment, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)3, The inclusion of and/or expansion of recycling facilities for processing Class A recyclable materials constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, the modification/expansion of 200 tpd of Class A recyclable materials at the NY/NJ Recycling, LLC recycling facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C 7:26-6.11 (f).
