The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority District Solid Waste Management Plan (District Plan) dated June 24, 2025. This amendment to the District Plan proposes District Plan inclusion of revised hours of operation for the SAJO Transport Inc. Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility and Class A Recycling Center, located at 100 Baler Boulevard, Block 175, Lot 1, and Block 177, Lot 1 in the Borough of North Arlington. This request proposes to revise the hours of operation for accepting, processing, recovering, and transferring waste to 24 hours per day, Monday through Saturday. The current hours of operation for the acceptance of waste are 6:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, and 6:00 am to 3:30 pm, Saturday. The current hours of operation for the processing and loading of waste are 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, Monday through Saturday.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of revised hours of operation can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the District Plan inclusion of revised hours of operation at the SAJO Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11.
