Dear Mr. Kuhlwein:

On May 13, 2005 the Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste received a request for an administrative action to include in the Ocean County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) the Supreme Computer and Electronic Recyclers expanded list of materials that are to be accepted at their Class D Recycling Center at 1955 Swathmore Avenue, Lakewood Township. The list of materials currently consists of computer components and electronic equipment. The list would now include fluorescent bulbs, batteries, and ballasts. Supreme Computer and Electronic Recycler will consolidate these materials at their facility. However, the receipt of ballasts at this Class D recycling center is dependent upon the Class D recycling center approval for such materials.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5., on-site operational changes at an existing facility may be considered for approval through the administrative action process. Therefore, this amendment is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this Administrative Action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a Class D Recycling Center Approval to Supreme Computer and Electronic Recycler.
