The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Ocean County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 27, 2020. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the modification to the daily incoming capacity of Rubbercycle, LLC located on Block 1609, Lot 2802 at 1985 Rutgers University Blvd. in the Township of Lakewood from 84 tons per day (tpd) of scrap tires to 150 tpd of scrap tires.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b)14, the expansion of a recycling facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, this request for County Plan inclusion of the daily capacity increase to 150 tpd of scrap tires at the Rubbercycle, LLC Recycling Center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f).
