The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Passaic County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 16, 2025. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of weekly averaging for the solid waste throughput capacity at the Gaeta Recycling Co., Inc. Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility located at 278 West Railway Avenue in the City of Paterson. This request proposes to maintain an average daily throughput capacity of 720 tons per day, equivalent to its current daily limit while operating 6 days a week, which is a weekly capacity of 4,320 tons per week. This request proposes to accept up to a maximum of 1,200 tons per day on any peak day(s) while remaining at or below 4,320 tons per week as a limit.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)8, the inclusion of weekly averaging can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of weekly averaging at the Gaeta Recycling Co., Inc. is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11.
