The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Passaic County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 4, 2015. Administrative Action 001-15 to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the name change of the following three (3) Covanta 4Recovery, LP TS/MRFs to Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC:


- Fulton Street – Block 3115, Lots 5 and 17 in the City of Paterson;
- River Street – Block 3106, Lots 2-6 and 8-13 in the City of Paterson; and,
- Totowa – Block 170.02, Lot 3 in the Borough of Totowa.

These facilities will now be known as Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC – Fulton Street, Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC – River Street and Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC – Totowa. Administrative Action 001-15 reads that no operational changes will occur at the subject facilities as a result of this name change.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of a change in name of an existing solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the change in name of Covanta 4Recovery, LP to Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
