The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Passaic County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated December 11, 2023. Administrative Amendment 002-23 to the County Plan proposes plan inclusion of a name change from Green Sky Industries Inc. to Recycle City; expansion of Recycle City's Class A recycling center for fiber materials to a capability of producing 300 tons per day of various Class A materials; the addition of an updated single stream/commingled sorting system within an existing processing building, while continuing its current bailing operation within its existing bailing enclosures; and the modification of hours from: Monday thru Friday: 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, & Saturday: 7:00 am to 12:00 pm to Monday thru Friday: 6:30 am to 4:00 pm (receipt of materials), Monday thru Friday: 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm (processing/shipment) and Saturday: 7:00 am to 3:00 pm (receipt/processing). Recycle City is located at 41 Broad Street, Clifton, New Jersey, Block 15.02, Lot 1.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b), the above referenced actions can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of Recycle City is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14.
