The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Somerset County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated November 28, 2017. The request proposes County Plan inclusion of a modified block and lot designation for the Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center located in the Township of Franklin. Specifically, the block and lot designation included in the County Plan is proposed to be modified from Block 1, Lot 2 to Block 5.02, Lot 1.02.

The County Plan inclusion of the modified block and lot designation of the Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center will not result in any operational changes at the facility which is included in the County Plan to accept up to 1,500 tons per day of brick, block, concrete and asphalt.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, a change in the block and lot designation of an existing solid waste or recycling facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the modified block and lot designation for the Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center located at Block 5.02, Lot 1.02 is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
