The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Sussex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 27, 2020. The request proposes to include a Research, Development and Demonstration (RD&D) project for the acceptance and processing of up to 25 tons per day of tires to be conducted at the Cavalier Environmental Compliance Services, Inc. Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Services (TS/MRF) located at 482 Houses Corner Road on Block 16005, Lots 5 & 6 in the Township of Sparta.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)13, the inclusion of an operation of a RD&D project can be accomplished via an administrative action.
