Dear Mr. Dech:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste (DEP) is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Warren County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated January 15, 2016. The request proposes a pilot program at Covanta Warren Energy Resource Co., LLC (Covanta) to last for approximately six months through June 30, 2016. This project will involve receiving liquid wastes (waste type 72) from various industrial facilities that currently cause upset conditions at Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) and injecting the waste into each boiler to test the limits of the current injection system to determine if it can handle additional volume, flow rates and material. Covanta has applied to the DEP to conduct this pilot program as a Research, Development and Demonstration (RD&D) project.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)13, the inclusion of an operation of a RD&D project can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the pilot program at Covanta Warren Energy Resource Co., LLC is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
