Dear Mr. Moncman,

The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 2, 2013. The April 2, 2013 request for administrative action proposes County Plan inclusion of the modification and/or addition of several source separated materials to the lists of "designated" and "recommended" recyclable materials as a result of the recent conversion to single stream collection and processing at the Authority's Intermediate Processing Facility.

A summary of attached "designated" recyclable list follows: paper products; glass food & beverage cans; metal food & beverage cans, plastic containers; computers & consumer electronics; white goods; leaves, grass clippings; brush; tree branches; tree stumps & Christmas trees; wood pallets; propane tanks; tires; antifreeze; used motor oil; used oil filters; lead acid batteries; consumer rechargeable NiCad & small sealed lead acid batteries; auto & truck bodies; asphalt & concrete; contaminated soil; and, commercial grease. The summary of the "recommended" recyclable list follows: bulky mixed rigid plastics; film plastic; paint; street sweepings & catch basin cleanout; residential cooking oil; textiles; non-chemically treated construction wood; hardback books; and, commercial & institutional food waste.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 6, the modifications of a recycling program constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
