The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated November 21, 2012. The November 21, 2012 request for administrative action proposes County Plan inclusion of creating a one hundred (100) foot wide buffer zone to comply with the provisions of the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority's (CMCMUA) Sanitary Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit whereas the setback area from the landfill shall be no less than 150 feet from the property line.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5, the modifications of an existing facility including creating facility buffer zones constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
