Section 1 (Downloading the Form):

Save a local copy of the PDF file “2022 CPCN Annual Collector Transporter Utility Report.pdf”.

In order to use all of the features the file will need to be opened in Adobe Acrobat Reader with a version of Adobe Reader XI or higher. It is a free software available for download at <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>.

**** Please note – Do not print out this form to complete by hand. This form will be read electronically. It is strongly recommended to save your form after each page that is completed. ****

Section 2 (New Features):

New features of the fillable form include the ability to duplicate pages, attach files, calculate buttons, and submit digital signatures.

Section 2A (Duplicating Pages):

On some pages, you may need additional space to provide all the required information. If you need additional space on a page, click on the “Duplicate This Page” button at the bottom of the screen. A blank copy of that page will be added to the end of the document.

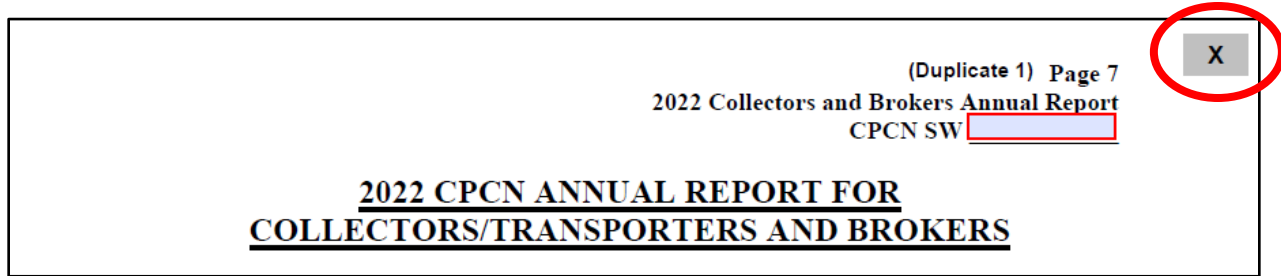

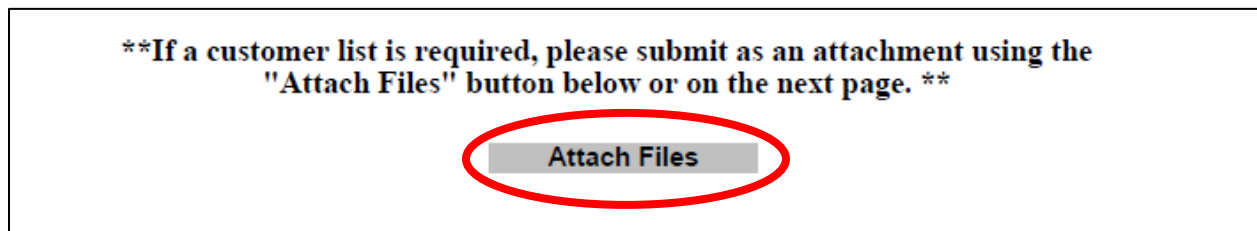
Duplicate This Page

If a page was accidentally duplicated or is no longer needed, it may be deleted where there is an “X” button at the top right. Clicking this “X” will delete the page from the document.

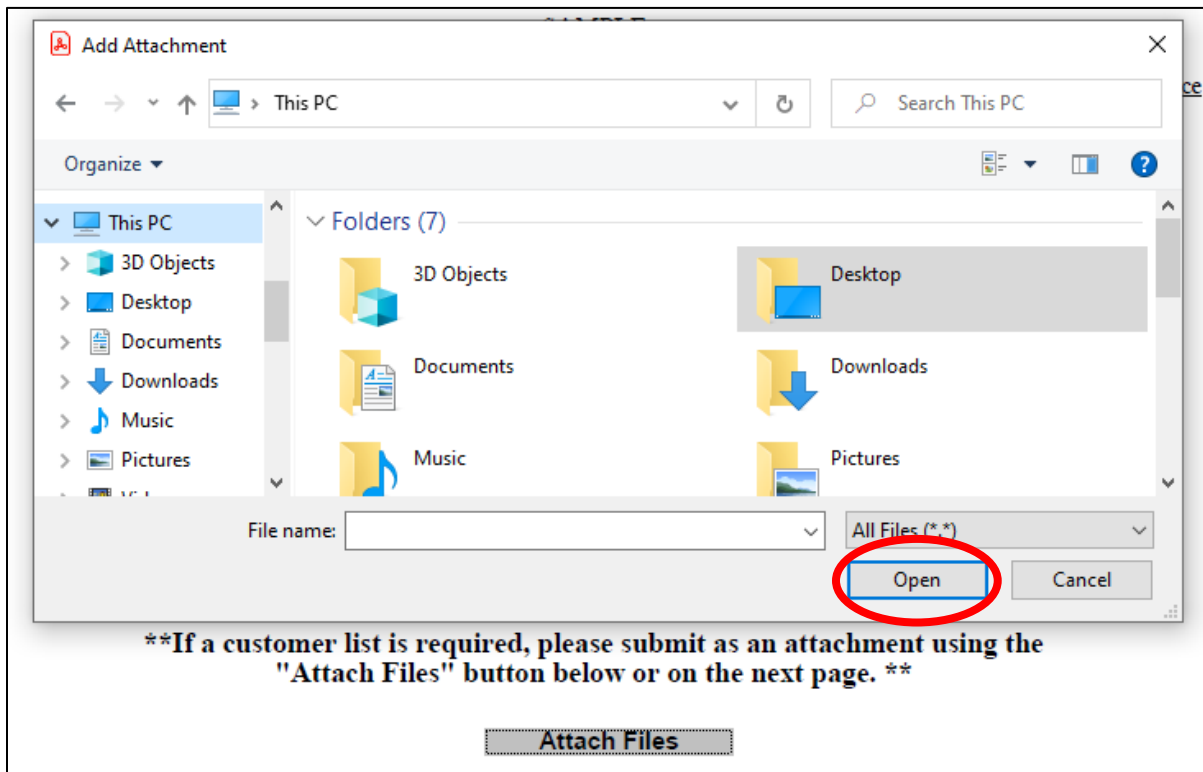


Section 2B (Attaching Documents):

Additional documents that are required to be submitted must be attached directly to the PDF. Pages that request additional documents contain an “Attach Files” button.



Clicking the “Attach Files” button will bring up a “File Explorer” window. Browse to the location on your computer where the file you wish to attach is located. Select the file and click “Open”. The file is now attached to the document.



Section 2C (Customer List):

If you are required to attach a customer list based on the information you've added on page 15 of the report (Customer Service Area Inventory), please note that the list will be treated as a confidential document and will not be subject to public review pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26H-5.9(c)(4).

Section 2D (Calculate Totals):

“Calculate Totals” buttons have been added to pages that require calculations (20, 22 & 27). Clicking the “Calculate Totals” buttons will calculate the totals on all pages that require calculations. Please note that calculations may take a few seconds to complete.

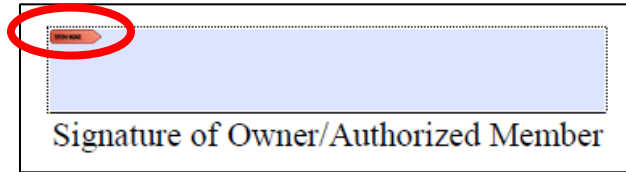

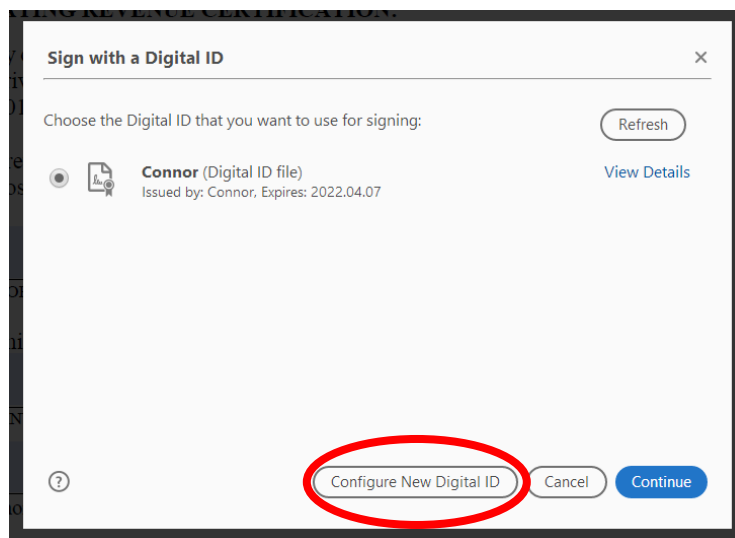

Section 2E (Digital Signatures):

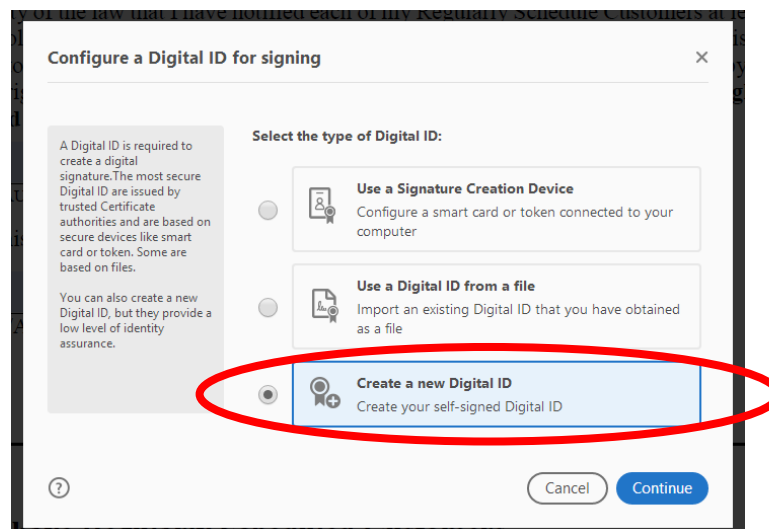
The form contains the ability to use digital signatures. Both the Owner/Authorized Member signature and the notary signature referenced in Section 3 below are required digital signatures. A signature field will be denoted by having a red mark in the top left corner of the field (see below).



Clicking on the signature field will bring up a prompt with steps instructing users to sign with a digital ID. The first step is to click the “Configure New Digital ID” button.



If you do not already have a Digital ID file on your computer then select the third option, “Create a new Digital ID” and click continue.



Select the “Save to File” option and click continue. Then enter your information and create a password

Select the destination of the new Digital ID

Digital IDs are typically issued by trusted providers that assure the validity of the identity. Self-signed Digital ID may not provide the same level of assurance and may not be accepted in some use cases. Consult with your recipients if this is an acceptable form of authentication.

Section 3 (Notary Signature):

Please email or bring a saved copy to your notary on a flash drive. Once you are in the presence of your notary, please fill out the fields and signature on page 32. After all the fields have been completed, have the notary click in the red bordered box labeled, “Sign Notary”.
