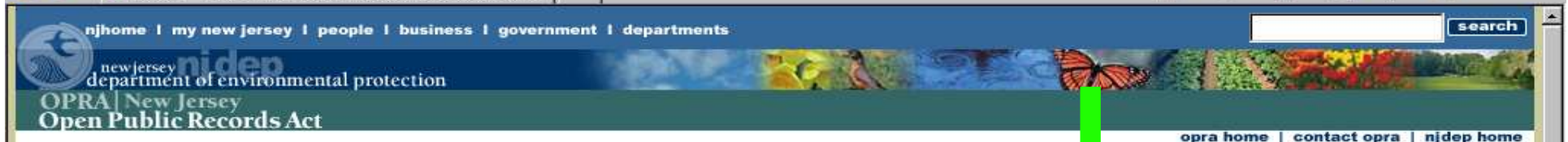

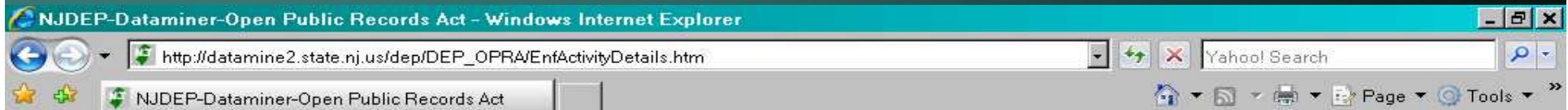

• Compliance & Enforcement - Activity Details

- **Compliance Evaluations** -These reports display detailed information about all types of compliance evaluations that have been finalized (reviewed and approved by a supervisor). These are typically planned site inspections but may include complaint investigations, sampling efforts, compliance assistance and in-office reviews of gathered or submitted data and information. These are typically related to a single program but may be multi-program activities. When multiple programs are involved these reports will usually reflect each program's concerns as a new record, but with the same activity identifiers and date. The different reports within this category allow the user to search for inspections by Program Interest ID, County, Municipality, Enforcement Program, Site ID and Date Range.

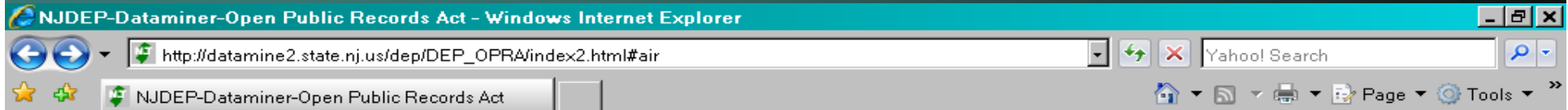

- **Air Quality Permitting and Reporting**

This area contains reports about Air Quality Permitting and Emission Statements:

- The Air Quality Permitting Program is responsible for permitting and testing stationary sources of air pollution to ensure they do not adversely affect air quality. To accomplish this, the staff of the AQPP reviews air pollution control permit applications, evaluates air quality modeling and risk assessments, and audits stack emissions measurements.
- Emission Statements are intended to help the state agencies in their reporting and analysis of emissions into the outdoor air. All emission estimates reported on Emission Statements will be used in tracking the State's progress toward meeting the mandatory emission reduction targets specified as a percentage reduction from the 1990 base year inventory. This tracking will help to monitor the progress that areas make toward attainment of the ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard and will be used as an indicator to measure the State's progress in maintaining a healthy environment.

- **Certified Laboratories**

The Office of Quality Assurance currently certifies the analytical capabilities of approximately 700 laboratories. Most of these are small to medium sized laboratories; and are laboratory facilities servicing a specific facility (water purveyor, industry, municipal authority).

Certification of laboratories is an ongoing process. Certifications are added and deleted for laboratories for various reasons every day. Therefore, the Office of Quality Assurance encourages all visitors to this site to verify the accreditation status of a laboratory by reviewing the laboratory's certificate and Annual Certified Parameter List issued by the NJDEP or by contacting one of the Office of Quality Assurance staff to verify the status of a laboratory.

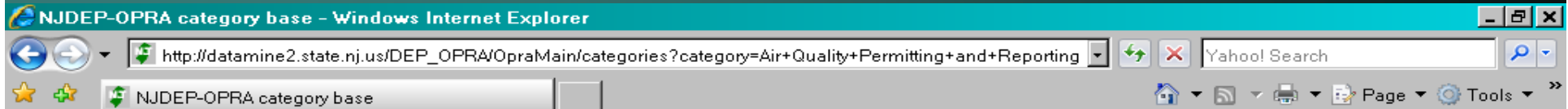

The Community Right to Know (CRTK) program is responsible for collecting and disseminating data on hazardous substances produced, stored or used at companies in New Jersey. These data are collected on the annual CRTK Survey. The CRTK program collects data on New Jersey CRTK regulated hazardous substances from facilities in industry codes covered under the CRTK regulations, as well as on non-New Jersey CRTK regulated hazardous substances from facilities regulated under the federal Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act (EPCRA). The following CRTK reports have been created. Please note that CRTK Surveys are due March 1 and include data for the previous calendar year.

- The first report entitled **Active CRTK Facilities with Inventory Above Threshold** provides information on active facilities regulated by New Jersey CRTK reporting requirements with inventory of CRTK regulated environmental hazardous substances (EHS's) above reporting thresholds. Due to domestic security concerns, reports must be generated one facility at a time, and in order to generate a report the facility name and street address must be entered as it appears in the program database. Therefore, you may need to utilize the report below entitled CRTK General Facility Information to obtain the name and street address as it is used in the database.
- The second report entitled **Active or Non-Active CRTK Facilities** provides information on all active or non-active facilities that according to our database, reported EHS inventory below the applicable thresholds, or reported that they do not have any inventory of EHS's, as well as those facilities regulated by the Federal Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act

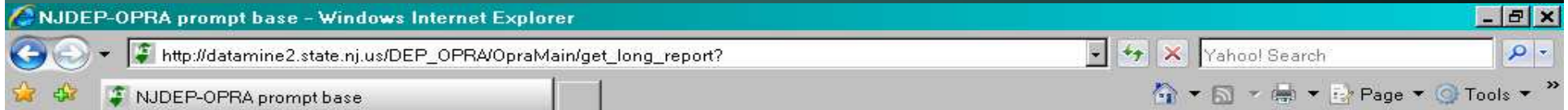
