The Air Quality Permitting Program is responsible for permitting and testing stationary sources of air pollution (e.g., factories, power plants, etc.) - both old sources (those already constructed) and newer facilities - to ensure they do not adversely affect air quality in your neighborhood or anywhere in the state.

To accomplish this, the staff of the AQPP reviews air pollution control permit applications, evaluates air quality impact and health risks; and ensures stack emissions are measured properly.

# Summary of the Changes

## MINOR AIR FACILITIES

### PRECONSTRUCTION PERMIT FEES

1. **44% increase for all permit/service fees.**
2. **\$820 for all GPs.**
3. **New supplementary fee of \$8,417 for applications that trigger PSD regulations and require BACT evaluation, air quality modeling, etc.**

# Summary of the Changes

## MAJOR AIR FACILITIES

### OPERATING PERMIT FEES

1. **44% increase for all significant modifications (base and supplementary fees).**
2. **\$820 for all General Operating Permits.**
3. **\$842 for Environmental Improvement Pilot Tests (EIPTs) that are related to significant modifications (additional supplementary fees apply).**
4. **New flat fee of \$50,000 for significant modifications that trigger PSD or Sub 18 regulations. \$50,000 will cover all fees; no other base or supplementary fees will be required**
