New Invoicing of Solid Waste Compliance Monitoring Fees

Who is affected by this initiative?

All sanitary landfill operations, thermal destruction facilities, transfer stations, processing facilities, resource recovery facilities, and municipal solid waste composting or co-composting are affected.

What has changed?

For fiscal year 2006 (July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006), most invoices for compliance monitoring fees will be issued quarterly, beginning in July 2005. Unless the fee is listed as an ANNUAL FEE in the table below, you will receive a quarterly invoice. For those fees listed in the table below as ANNUAL FEE, the invoice will be issued in July of each year. In previous years you received only one invoice containing both your compliance monitoring fee and the annual registration fee.

What will my bill be?

The compliance monitoring fees for each category are listed below:
