Failure to Notify the Department Regarding Incident with Potential Off-site Impact

The Department has noticed that some facilities are unaware of their responsibility under the Air Pollution Control Act to immediately notify the Department if they have a release which may have off site impacts. The information below is the legal citation and procedure to help you avoid the most common transgressions.

- A person who causes a release of air contaminants in a quantity or concentration which poses a potential threat to public health, welfare or the environment or which might reasonably result in citizen complaints is **required** to immediately notify the Department.
- 2. The facility representative or responsible person **must immediately call** the Department's Hotline at **1-877-WARN DEP (1-877-927-6337)** to report the release of air contaminants which pose a potential threat to the public health, welfare or the environment or which might result in citizen complaints.
- 3. The facility representative or responsible person should communicate all pertinent incident information to the DEP Hotline Operator and obtain a case number for future reference.
- 4. The legal obligation to notify the Department is <u>not</u> satisfied because local officials tell you don't have to call. **It is the responsibility of the facility to notify the Department**, not local police, fire, or emergency responders.
