A-901 Annual Update Submittal

Solid waste transporters who file Disclosure Statements, meet the Solid Waste Licensing requirements, and pass an Integrity Review by the New Jersey State Police and Attorney General's Office receive an approved "license" to transport solid waste in New Jersey known as an A-901 License. A requirement of the license is that all A-901 applicants, licensees, and Second Level business entities are required to submit an annual update of their business concern disclosure statement no later than November 1st each year. Failure to complete and submit the annual update may result in the termination of the A-901 license or application.
