Why would I need help?

As part of the *e*-government services strategy, the NJDEP Online web portal provides the regulated community an opportunity to obtain certain air permits cheaper and faster. This training will provide a general overview on general permits, as well as the Air Compliance and Enforcement inspection process (Inspection 101 – What to expect when an inspector comes to your facility), the 2010 Emission Statement, including and overview of issues encountered during the 2009 Emission Statement season, and the Diesel Program. Lastly, this workshop will update you on regulation changes pertaining to the Annual Combustion Adjustment, Vehicle Idling and Boiler Stack Test (N.J.A.C. 7:27-19) requirements.
