Why would I need help?

As the Federal and State Regulations are constantly evolving, this training will provide the regulated community information regarding several important topics. You will learn about the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants – Subpart 4Z (Stationary Reciprocating Internal Engines) and Subpart 6J (Industrial, Commercial, Institutional Boilers). NJDEP staff will teach you how to apply for and obtain Preconstruction Permits using Radius Software and General Permits using DEP Online. In addition, this training will also provide guidance on the Sulfur in Fuel Oil and the Environmental Stewardship Program at the DEP. You will also get to see and learn about the FLIR (forward looking infra-red) Camera. The day will conclude with a Question and Answer session to address all questions, comments and concerns.
