This seminar will provide information on how to get ready for an inspection, common enforcement findings, Supplemental Environmental Projects (SEPs) policy and SEP examples that directly benefit communities and the environment. Facilities that have Continuous Emission Monitoring Systems (CEMS), Continuous Opacity Monitoring Systems (COMS) and/or Stack Testing requirements will benefit from an overview provided by the Bureau of Technical Services. In addition, updates on new and proposed New Jersey Air Pollution Regulations will be provided by the Bureau of Air Quality Permitting. This seminar will also include training on navigating the NJDEP Online web portal and will cover a review of electronic submissions of Annual Compliance Certifications, Six Month Deviation Reports and Excess Emission & Monitoring Performance Reports (EEMPR). The day will conclude with a question and answer session.
