Upcoming FREE Air Compliance & Enforcement (ACE) Training/Outreach Seminar

Anyone who is interested in learning about, or who is subject to the state's Air Pollution regulations is encouraged to attend.

What will be covered at the Seminar?

This one-day training will provide information on multiple air pollution topics. The event will begin with a brief update on transformation efforts within the Air program. Additional web-based topics will include how to submit RADIUS and Emission Statements via the NJ Portal online system. Find out the applicability for Construction, Repair and Maintenance (CRM) Notifications and how to report it to the Department. Dry Cleaner and Gas Station regulations/requirements will also be reviewed. In the afternoon we will be presenting case studies from Hurricane Sandy outreach efforts. The day will conclude with a question and answer session.
