This training will provide information on multiple air pollution topics. We will kick off the morning with an update on what's new with the Air Compliance and Enforcement program. The morning presentations will include a review of air permit applicability, with detailed presentations on Waste Oil Heaters and Subchapter 16 requirements for Cold Degreasing operations. The morning session will be concluded by Air Permitting representatives who will provide updates on General Permits, Annual Certification issues, information on EPA's Cross Media Electronic Reporting Regulation and fee changes. If you have a multi-media question, be sure to attend the afternoon session where we will once again have a panel of enforcement representatives from Air, Hazardous Waste and Underground Storage Tanks, as well as Air Permitting, to answer your questions.
