NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION #2022-07 Issued: 07/08/2022

Amendments to the "Dirty Dirt Law" (N.J.S.A. 13:1E-127.1 et seq.) Requiring Registration for Soil and Fill Recycling Services

Who is affected by this Advisory?

Businesses that are engaged in "soil and fill recycling services" including "the collection, transportation, processing, brokering, storage, purchase, sale or disposition, or any combination thereof, of soil and fill recyclable materials" as defined in the "Dirty Dirt Law" at N.J.S.A. 13:1E-127 (the Act).

Why is the Department issuing this Advisory?

On July 5, 2022, Governor Phil Murphy signed Assembly Bill #4255, amending the Dirty Dirt Law. Pursuant to this amendment, the new deadlines for the Dirty Dirt Law are as follows:

- Any business concern that does not already hold an A-901 license and is engaged in, or otherwise provides, soil and fill recycling services must register with the NJDEP no later than July 14, 2022.
- The deadline for soil and fill recycling registrants to submit a valid and administratively complete application for an A-901 license is extended to <u>one month after the NJDEP adopts</u> <u>rules and regulations</u> pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act to implement the soil and fill recycling services law requiring an A-901 license.
- Any business concern that seeks to engage in soil and fill recycling services after July 14, 2022 and has not submitted a registration form must file an application for an A-901 license and is not permitted to engage in soil and fill recycling services until such business concern has received its A-901 license.

What should I do?

Businesses that are engaged in soil and fill recycling services should make a point to register at https://www.nj.gov/dep/dshw/a901/soil fill registration form.pdf before July 14, 2022. There is no cost to register.
